# FORSYTH COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS Meeting Minutes September 16, 2025 – 11:00 a.m.

#### **Meeting Called to Order**

A meeting of the Forsyth County Board of Elections was called to order in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Board Room on Tuesday, September 16, 2025 at 11:01 a.m., Chairperson A.L. Collins presiding.

## **Motion to Approve Meeting Agenda**

#### **Report on Hand-to-Eye Audit**

Deputy Director Michelle Bobadilla presented to the Board that a bipartisan team performed the hand-to-eye audit which was open to the public. The State Board of Elections randomly selected two precincts, 091 and 034, for the audit. Mrs. Bobadilla explained that the sample audit count is required by statute and helps ensure the reliability of election results tabulated by a machine. The audit is a comparison of the machine counts with hand-to-eye counts completed as a test to ensure voting equipment reads the voter's choices accurately. Mrs. Bobadilla reported that no discrepancies were found. Member Draper moved to accept the hand-to-eye audit; Member Harvey seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.** 

#### Report on Audit and Reconciliation

Adam Clark, Elections Systems Manager, informed the Board that there were no discrepancies with the Audit and Reconciliation Report. Member Draper moved to approve the reported information; Member Harvey seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.** 

#### **Certification of the 2025 Municipal Primary Election**

Director Tsujii informed the Board that action was needed to certify the 2025 municipal primary elections for Rural Hall and Tobaccoville. Member Draper moved to certify the September 9, 2025 municipal primary elections for Rural Hall and Tobaccoville; Secretary Doomy seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**
